






Q5. The school offers opportunities for pupils to talk about their feelings




Q7. Longwill listend to pupils views and acts upon them


Q8. Longwill values pupils as individuals , encouraging them to do their best


Q9. Longwill rewards and motivates pupils to do their best


Q10. Longwill is willing & able to offer pupils extra help when they need it




Q12. Longwill is a safe and secure environment, encouraging pupils to contribute in class






Q16. Parents feel comfortable to approach the school for support or with concerns
